Then, started a workshop of his own on the shores of Lake Biwa in Japan. Emigrated to Canada in 1998. While engaged in the design of the Shimano lure company between 2001 and 2006, contributed to a Japanese fishing magazine for fishing in Canada. Launched Nishine Lure Works in 2006 in Vancouver, BC and moved to St. Catharines, Ontario for better fishing in 2011. Over 23 years experience.



### Yutaka Amemiya

Received his Ph.D. in Fish Biology from Kitasato University, Japan. Has over 30 years river and ocean fishing experience, including deep sea fishing and fly fishing in both Japan and Canada. His research career has been recognized both nationally and internationally, which includes six Japanese and International awards and over 30 original publications.
